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COHORT ELIGIBILITY

Below is a list of criteria an interested disadvantaged business enterprise (DBE) must have to be eligible to participate in the program in the following southwest region: CA, NV, HI, and AZ.

- Participant must be a primary owner, key manager, or administrator of the participating business
- **102** Existing in business for at least 2 consecutive years
- Have minimum of 2 full-time employees (including owner)
- Interested in improving credit, capacity, and character evaluation with a surety representative
- Have revenue in excess of \$200,000
- Must have at least one of the following business certifications or in the process of becoming certified as:
 - Small Business Enterprise (SB)
 - Small Disadvantaged Business (SDB)
 - Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBE)
 - Women Owned Small Businesses (WOSB)
 - Women business Enterprises (WBE)
 - Historically Underutilized Business Zone (Hub Zone)
 - Service-Disabled Veteran Owned Business (SDVOB)
 - Veteran Owned Small Business (VOSB)
 - Minority Business Enterprise (MBE)
 - SBA's 8(a) Development Program
 - Minority & Woman Business Enterprise (MWBE)



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
