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

Evaluation and Award

(Refer to RFP Section III, p. 16)

• All proposals, timely received, will be evaluated using the following evaluation criteria:

Qualifications of the firm	25%
Staffing and project organization	25%
Work plan	30%
Cost and price	20%

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Evaluation and Award (continued)

- "Short-Listed" firms will be invited to interview.
- Interviews are scheduled for May 4, 2021. Offerors are requested to keep this date available.

Award

- Award Process
 - Evaluation Committee will select highest ranking Offeror for award.
 - All firms submitting a proposal will be notified of Award via CAMM NET.
