

Proposal Submittal Instructions (continued)

- Authority has the right to:
 - accept or reject any and all proposals;
 - withdraw or cancel the RFP;
 - postpone proposal opening for its own convenience.
- Proposals received are considered public information
- Proposals are not to be copyrighted

Proposal Content (continued)

- Offeror shall submit proposed pricing to provide services described in Exhibit A, Scope of Work
- Offerors shall complete the Excel file entitled OCTA RVS PriceSheets.xlsm
- Offerors shall only enter pricing as directed by the Price Summary Sheet instructions provided in the RFP
- Offerors shall make no changes to the Price Summary Sheet form

Evaluation and Award

 All proposals, timely received, will be evaluated using the following <u>evaluation criteria</u>:

Qualifications of the firm	20%
Staffing and project organization	20%
Work plan	35%
Cost & Price	25%

Evaluation and Award (continued)

- "Short-Listed" firms will be invited to interview
- Interviews are scheduled for May 10, 2023
- Offerors are requested to keep this date available



- Award Process
 - -Evaluation Committee recommends highest ranking Offeror to the Finance and Administration (F&A) Committee
 - The F&A Committee makes recommendation to Board of Directors (BOD)
 - -BOD may accept/reject staff's recommendation
 - -All firms submitting a proposal will be notified of award via CAMM NET

Project Overview and Scope of Work

Rider Validation System Goals

- Improve customer convenience and experience
- Facilitate fare policy equity and innovation
- Validate ridership for revenue reimbursement for pass programs and improve data collection for analysis capabilities
- Reduce onboard cash usage, bus dwell time and operator workload
- Enhance intermodal and regional interoperability

Key Features of the RVS

- Account-based back office utilizing a proven design that has been previously deployed in a comparable transit environment
- Issuance of contactless smartcard fare media, with support for other forms of fare media
- Deploy a retail network of "gift card" retail locations where customers can purchase and reload electronic fare media
- Support for modern and innovative fare policies including stored value, reduced fares, fare capping, institutional programs, and other special programs
- Ability to accept Open Payments including contactless debit/credit cards and mobile wallets such as Apple and Google Pay

Key Features of the RVS

- Deployment of public and institutional websites that offer comprehensive account management and administrative features
- Ability to manage and process transactions from several channels including fare validators (bus and rail), TVM, websites, inspection devices, mobile ticketing, and retail network
- Electronic payment processing compliant with PCI and EMV standards
- PCI compliant hosted or cloud-based central management system to manage and configure the system, in addition to reporting and data querying capabilities.
- Open architecture with unrestricted access to system API to allow future integration and expansion of the system.

Key Features of the RVS

- Option for an integrated mobile ticketing solution
 - Shares a common back office with RVS
 - Utilizes modern design and functionality
 - Ability to customize text and key design elements
 - Proven quality control and standardized maintenance releases
 - Experience troubleshooting and resolving bugs efficiently
 - Ability to pay with cash at retail network

RVS Timeline

- Aggressive but flexible
 - 18 months from NTP to final acceptance
 - 2 design review phases
 - Lab and Field testing
 - Pilot prior to system acceptance testing
