Proposal Submittal Instructions

- Proposals are due by 2:00 p.m., December 20, 2023
- Proposals are to be submitted to the address specified in the RFP
- Submit **one (1) original proposal** sealed and clearly identified on exterior of package as specified in the RFP.
- Proposers shall also include **one (1) electronic copy** of their submittal package in PDF format on a CD, DVD, or flash drive.
- Proposal package to be clearly marked with RFP number and title

Proposal Submittal Instructions (continued)

- Authority has the right to:
 - accept or reject any and all proposals;
 - withdraw or cancel the RFP;
 - postpone proposal opening for its own convenience.
- Proposals received are considered public information
- Proposals are not to be copyrighted

- Offeror shall submit proposed pricing to provide services described in Exhibit A, Scope of Work
- The Offeror shall complete and sign the "Price Summary Sheet" form included with this RFP (Exhibit B)

Evaluation and Award

 All proposals, timely received, will be evaluated using the following <u>evaluation criteria</u>:

Qualifications of the firm	20%
Staffing and project organization	
Work plan	30%
Cost and Price	25%

 Evaluation Committee comprised of internal OCTA staff and external members

Evaluation and Award (continued)

- "Short-Listed" firms will be invited to interview
- Interviews are scheduled for January 18, 2023
- Offerors are requested to keep this date available

Award

Award Process

- Evaluation Committee recommends highest ranking Offeror to the Regional Transit Planning (RTP) Committee
- The RTP Committee makes recommendation to Board of Directors (BOD)
- BOD may accept/reject staff's recommendation
- All firms submitting a proposal will be notified of Award via CAMM NET


