- Q1: Are you guys looking for some noise blankets to hang in your fencing?I make all kinds, I have a great reputation in the industry, let me know if you need them STC 28 STC 32.
- A1: No.
- Q2: I just reviewed a NIB for the Project, named "Fence Installation at Pacific Electric Right of Way in Anaheim." The NIB stated the required Bidder's License to hold C13 or A. May we participate in the bid if we have the General "B" License with C-23 (Ornamental Metal Contractor); or hiring subcontractors who have license C-13? Please advise with License Requirements Clarification ASAP prior to the Scheduled Pre-Bid Conference Date (Feb. 20, 2024). Upon your confirmation, I will join the Pre-Bid Conference & Schedule to site visiting.
- A2: In conjunction with Addendum No. 2 (Item No. 2), Bidders are advised that the project contractor will be required to comply with at least one of the following license requirements:
  - hold a valid State of California C-13 (Fencing Contractor) specialty class license, or
  - hold a valid State of California A general engineering contractor license and subcontract a valid state of California C-13 specialty licensed contractor, or
  - hold a valid State of California B general building contractor license and subcontract a valid state of California C-13 specialty licensed contractor.
- **Q3:** I am with Quality fence. I wanted to see if due to the rain was the bid walk rescheduled for, Fence Installation at Pacific Electric Right of Way in Anaheim ?
- A3: No, the site visit was not rescheduled.

- Q5: 1. Please provide name and contact number for the representative of the fencing manufacturer for this project. 2. May a C license contractor work under my A license without being listed ? (As allowed per Public Contract Code)

1) After Reviewing the Project Plans & Specs, we realized the required "Securifor 4D Security Fence – Manufactured by BetaFence" is an Ornamental Fence. The required license by CSLB Classifications to perform this kind of fence is C23 (Ornamental Metal Contractor). If we have B & C23 Licenses, may we self-perform to participate in the project? If OCTA accepts, please revise the License requirement to add C23 in the Spec.

2) Please Confirm that there are no additional concrete curb or mow curb under the new fences.

3) The Sidewalk and Concrete Curb are existing and no (N) concrete curb or mow curb are required per plan. Is the 3<sup>rd</sup> party land surveying report required at the end of the project?

4) There is a Fencing Product (FEN-1) Note stating that Fence Height is 6' typical (Small Section of 7' high panels surrounding swing gates along ball road); however, there is no 7' high panels' detail on the elevation views on detail 3/A2.01. Please indicate the 7' high panels on the elevation view.

5) KN 20 on Plan A1.01 called for Four (4) inches of Bark Mulch installation. Please provide the Size (SF) of (N) Mulch Area for a fair bidding price practicing among the bidders.

# A7: A7.1 – Please refer to Answer 2 above regarding license requirements for project contractor.

A7.2 – There are no additional concrete curb or mow curb under the new fences.

A7.3 – 3<sup>rd</sup> party land surveying report is not required at the end of the project.

A7.4 – The project does not include 7' high panels; please refer to Attachment C – Revised Drawing Sheet A6.01.

## A7.5 – Areas of new mulch totals 3,000 sf.

Q8: As I stated in the previous email, the Betafence distibutor in Californua informed the plan specified model is not available currently and they offered a substitute fence product as I substitute requested. You may contact a distributor, Master Halco – Highland, CA (Ph. 909-350-4740) if you need further assistance.




