The Orange County Transportation Authority (Authority) invites statements of qualifications (SOQ) from qualified contractors to design, construct and deliver a turnkey hydrogen fueling station and facility modifications at the Garden Grove Bus Base (Project).

The Project will be a start to finish design-build project. It will be the responsibility of the selected design-build team to produce and present a complete design of the facility during the subsequent Request for Proposals (RFP) process.

The design-build effort is anticipated to span approximately 24 months. Contractor is anticipated to provide an operational training and transitional period not to exceed 18 months after completion and acceptance of the Project.

The Project's budget is estimated at \$12 million.

A separate future procurement will be issued by Authority for a firm to provide consultant construction management services to oversee the construction activities on this Project.

To prevent potential conflicts of interest, the following prohibitions apply to this solicitation:

The prime consultant and all subconsultants (at any tier), regardless of the level of service provided by said subcontractor(s), awarded this contract to design and build a turnkey hydrogen fueling station at the Garden Grove Bus Base are precluded from participating in the future **construction management services contract for this Project**.

Please note that by submitting a Proposal, Offeror certifies that it is not subject to any Ukraine/Russia-related economic sanctions imposed by the

State of California or the United States Government including, but not limited to, Presidential Executive Order Nos. 13660, 13661, 13662, 13685, and 14065. Any individual or entity that is the subject of any Ukraine/Russia-related economic sanction is not eligible to submit a Proposal. In submitting a Proposal, all Offerors agree to comply with all economic sanctions imposed by the State or U.S. Government.

By submitting a SOQ, Offeror represents that it has thoroughly examined and become familiar with the work required under this RFQ and that it is capable of performing quality work to achieve the Authority's objectives.

D. ADDENDA

The Authority reserves the right to revise the RFQ documents. Any Authority changes to the requirements will be made by written addendum to this RFQ. Any written addenda issued pertaining to this RFQ shall be incorporated into the terms and conditions of any resulting agreement. The Authority will not be bound to any modifications to or deviations from the requirements set forth in this RFQ as the result of oral instructions. Offerors shall acknowledge receipt of addenda in their SOQs. Failure to acknowledge receipt of addenda may cause the SOQ to be deemed non-responsive to this RFQ and be rejected.

4. Acceptance of SOQs

- a. The Authority reserves the right to accept or reject any and all SOQs, or any item or part thereof, or to waive any informalities or irregularities in SOQs.
- b. Terminate evaluations of submittals received.
- c. Modify dates set or projected in this RFQ.
- d. Issue addenda to this RFQ.
- e. The Authority reserves the right to withdraw or cancel this RFQ at any time without prior notice and the Authority makes no representations that any RFP will be issued or any contract will be awarded to any Offeror responding to this RFQ.
- f. The Authority reserves the right to issue a new RFQ for the project.
- g. The Authority reserves the right to postpone SOQ openings for its own convenience.
- h. The Authority reserves the right to investigate the qualifications of any Offeror, and/or require additional evidence of qualifications to perform the work.
- i. Submitted SOQs are not to be copyrighted, and once received become the property of the Authority.

H. VALIDITY PERIOD

Offeror's statement of qualifications shall remain valid for a period of not less than 180 days from the date of submittal.

I. PRE-CONTRACTUAL EXPENSES

The Authority shall not, in any event, be liable for any pre-contractual expenses incurred by Offeror in the preparation of its SOQ package. Offeror shall not include any such expenses as a part of its SOQ package.

J. JOINT OFFERS

Where two or more firms desire to submit a single proposal in response to this RFQ, they should form a Design-Build Entity. Members of the Design-Build Entity shall include the general contractor and, if utilized in the design of the project, all electrical, mechanical, and plumbing contractors. The Authority intends to contract with the Design-Build Entity awarded a contract for this Project.

K. CONTRACT TYPE

It is anticipated that the Agreement resulting from the subsequent RFP, if awarded, will be a firm-fixed price, lump-sum design-build contract.

L. CONFLICT OF INTEREST

All Offerors responding to this RFQ must avoid organizational conflicts of interest which would restrict full and open competition in this procurement. An organizational conflict of interest means that due to other activities, relationships or contracts, an Offeror is unable, or potentially unable to render impartial assistance or advice to the Authority; an Offeror's objectivity in performing the work identified in the Scope of Work is or might be otherwise impaired; or an Offeror has an unfair competitive advantage. Conflict of Interest issues must be fully disclosed in the Offeror's SOQ.

Offerors hired to perform services for the Authority are prohibited from concurrently acting as an advocate for another firm who is competing for a contract with the Authority, either as a prime or subcontractor.

M. CODE OF CONDUCT

All Offerors agree to comply with the Authority's Code of Conduct as it relates to Third-Party contracts which is hereby referenced and by this reference is incorporated herein. All Offerors agree to include these requirements in all of its subcontracts.

N. OWNERSHIP OF RECORDS/PUBLIC RECORDS ACT

All proposals and documents submitted in response to this RFQ shall become the property of the Authority and a matter of public record pursuant to the California Public Records Act, Government Code sections 7920.000 et seq. (the "Act"). Offerors should familiarize themselves with the provisions of the Act requiring

disclosure of public information. Offerors are discouraged from marking their proposal documents as "confidential" or "proprietary."

If a Proposal does include "confidential" or "proprietary" markings and the Authority receives a request pursuant to the Act, the Authority will endeavor (but cannot guarantee) to notify the Offeror of such a request. In order to protect any information submitted within a Proposal, the Offeror must pursue, at its sole cost and expense, any and all appropriate legal action necessary to maintain the confidentiality of such information. The Authority generally does not consider pricing information, subcontractor lists, or key personnel, including resumes, as being exempt from disclosure under the Act. In no event shall the Authority or any of its officers, directors, employees, agents, representatives, or consultants be liable to a Offeror for the disclosure of any materials or information submitted in response to the RFQ or by failing to notify a Offeror of a request seeking its Proposal. The Authority reserves the right to make an independent decision to disclose records and material.

Notwithstanding the above, all information regarding proposal responses will be held as confidential until such time as the evaluation has been completed; an award has been made by the Board of Directors or Authority Staff, as appropriate; and the contract has been fully negotiated.

O. PROHIBITIONS

The following prohibition apply to this procurement:

The prime consultant and all subconsultants (at any tier), regardless of the level of service provided by said subcontractor(s), awarded this contract to design and build a turnkey hydrogen fueling station at the Garden Grove Bus Base are precluded from participating in the future construction management services contract for this Project.

P. INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

The Design-Builder, at the Design-Builder's sole cost and expense and for the full term of the Design-Build contract or any extension thereof, will be required to obtain and maintain, at a minimum, all the insurance requirements outlined in **Exhibit B,** Insurance Requirements. Additional details will be provided during the RFP process.

Q. BOND REQUIREMENTS

During the RFP process, the Design-Build Entity will be required to provide a certified or cashier's check, or by a corporate surety bond on a form acceptable to Authority. Said check or bidder's bond shall be in an amount not less than 10% of the estimated construction cost for this project's budget.

The Design-Builder awarded the contract after the RFP process will be required to deliver to Authority performance and payment bonds on forms acceptable to Authority in the full amount of the estimated construction costs to guarantee the faithful performance and payments. For the purposes of providing performance and payment bonds, the estimated construction cost for this Project is 100% of the Project value. Authority reserves the right to reject any bond if, in the opinion of Authority, the Surety's acknowledgment is not in the form as prescribed by law. Authority reserves the right to negotiate the bonding level requirements.

R. OBLIGATION TO KEEP PROJECT TEAM INTACT

Offerors are advised that all firms and key personnel identified in the SOQ shall remain on the project team for the duration of the procurement process and execution of the Project. If extraordinary circumstances require a change, it must be submitted in writing to Authority. Authority, at its sole discretion, will determine whether to authorize a change, recognizing that certain circumstances (such as death or termination of employment) may occur that are beyond the Design-Builder's control. Unauthorized changes to the Project Team at any time during the procurement process may result in elimination of the Offeror from further consideration.

S. APPEAL FOR DENIAL OF PRE-QUALIFICATION

By agreeing to participate and submit a pre-qualification package pursuant to this RFQ, Offeror agrees to be bound by the appeal process set forth herein. All Offerors who submitted timely and complete SOQ packages, who are denied qualification may request an Appeal Hearing by submitting written notice of its appeal of the decision to the Authority Contact as specified in paragraph R of this section within five (5) business days of receipt of the decision. Without a timely appeal, the Offeror agrees that failure to timely submit said request waives any and all rights to challenge the decision of the Authority whether by administrative process, judicial process or any other legal process or proceeding.

If the Offeror provides the required notice of appeal and requests an appeal hearing, the hearing shall be conducted to conclude no later than ten (10) business days after the receipt of the written request notice.

The hearing shall be an informal process, to be conducted by the Chief Executive Officer or his/her designee, who is delegated responsibility to hear such appeals (Appeals Official.) Prior to the hearing the Offeror shall be advised of the basis of the Authority's pre-qualification determination. The Offeror shall be given the opportunity to present information and reasons in opposition to its rating. The Appeal Official shall render his/her decision within five (5) business days of conclusion of the hearing, and the Appeal Official's decision shall be binding and final.

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SECTION II: STATEMENT OF QUALIFICATION CONTENT

SECTION II. STATEMENT OF QUALIFICATION CONTENT

A. SOQ FORMAT AND CONTENT

1. Format

SOQs should be typed with a standard 12-point font, double-spaced, and submitted in 8 1/2" x 11" format. Charts and schedules may be included in 11" x 17" format. SOQs should not include any unnecessarily elaborate or promotional materials.

2. Design-Build Entity Information and Certification

Offerors shall complete and submit the following regarding the makeup of the Design-Build entity:

- a) Form A Letter of Transmittal and Certification: Offerors to provide organizational documentation for Offerors that are joint ventures, partnerships, or other associations; authorized representatives of all equity members of the Offeror shall sign the letter. Offeror is to provide a copy of the organizational documents or agreement committing to form the Design-Build entity. Offerors to indicate all shareholders, partners or members who will perform work on this Project.
- b) Form B Contact information: Offerors to provide contact information for the primary and secondary contact persons who will be the key contacts for all communications related to this RFQ and subsequent RFP.
- Form C Addenda Acknowledgement: Offerors to acknowledge receipt of all addenda issued by Authority to this RFQ.
- d) Offeror is required to provide a statement identifying any actual and/or potential conflicts of interests the firm may have with other clients they represent.

3. Project Team Information

Offerors shall complete and submit the following:

a) Form D - Project Team Information: The Design-Build entity should provide information for the members with significant roles on the Design-Build team, including information for the

General Contractor, Principal Engineering Firm, and design firm(s) as applicable to makeup of the Design-Build entity.

Offerors to provide explanation or documentation to any "yes" answers as indicated on Form D.

4. Minimum Requirements

Offerors are advised that the members of the Design-Build entity must meet minimum qualifications which will be evaluated on a pass-fail basis. Offerors are to complete and submit the forms as described below:

a) Form E - Design-Build Entity Minimum Requirements: This form seeks to assess if the Design-Build entity meets the minimum qualifications to work on the Project. Provide, in this section, any documentation and explanation to any "Yes" answers provided.

Offerors' responses provided as part of this Form E will be evaluated to determine whether the Design-Build entity is pre-qualified in this first step of the procurement process. A Design-Build entity that fails any of the questions 1 through 20, listed on the Form E, is automatically disqualified from further evaluation (except with respect to Question 20 to the extent the Design-Build entity is a party to an alternative dispute resolution system as identified in Question 20).

- b) Form F General Contractor Questions: This form seeks to assess the qualifications of the general contractor. A Design-Build Entity that "fails" any one of the questions 2 through 14 on Form F will be disqualified. Provide, in this section, any documentation and explanation to any "Yes" answers provided.
- c) Form G Principal Engineer Questions: This form seeks to assess the qualifications of the Principal Engineering firm. Failure to provide an explanation for a "yes" answer to questions 4 through 6 on Form G may result in Design-Build Entity disqualification. Provide, in this section, any documentation and explanation to any "Yes" answers provided.

5. Reference Projects

The Design-Build Entity shall submit complete project experience information demonstrating the Design-Build Team's experience, on Form H in accordance with the instructions that follow. Design-Build Entity shall provide complete project experience information that demonstrates comparable experience required by the Project.

Each of the reference projects must have been completed in the past seven (7) years immediately before the issuance of this RFQ. Projects must demonstrate the Design-Build Entity's experience with design and construction of public works projects (new or retrofit) in the United States and be over \$6 million project value in 2024 Dollars.

"Complete Project" means:

- (1) For the General Contractor, the construction work is 100% complete and the project has passed the start-up, testing, and commissioning for all facility system components; and
- (2) For the Principal Engineering Firm and Other Design Firms, the project design work is complete, and the construction is either in progress or completed.

"Project Value" represents the individual project cost, inclusive of engineering design costs, construction costs including start-up, testing and commissioning, and post construction tasks such as initial operation support services or process optimization services.

The Design-Build Entity shall submit reference projects that demonstrate:

- (1) Expert knowledge and experience in design and construction of public works facilities, preferably a transit facility; and
- (2) Direct design and/or construction experience with public transportation facilities; and
- (3) Experience with alternative project delivery methods (i.e., Design-Build, Design/Build-Operate, Construction Manager at Risk, etc.); and
- (4) Qualifications and experience relevant to the design and construction of this Project; and
- (5) Prior working relationships of the firms comprising the Design-Build Entity and Design-Build Team; and
- (6) Experience with planning, design, startup and commissioning of projects similar in size, scope and cost to this Project; and
- (7) Experience with post-construction services such as operations and maintenance, hydrogen fuel supply, support and process optimization services for public works facilities.

Offerors to complete and submit the following for the proposed **General Contractor's Construction Experience and Principal Engineering Firm's Design Experience**:

The Design-Build Entity shall identify a minimum of six (6) and not more than eight (8) completed projects by the General Contractor and the Principal Engineering Firm. Any project beyond the eighth will not be read nor considered.

- a) Form H Reference Project Data Sheet: Offerors shall submit this form for each of the reference projects, and reference projects must be checked as follows for the General Contractor and Principal Engineering Firm:
 - (1) At least three (3) projects must be attributed to the Principal Engineering firm of the Design-Build Team.
 - (2) At least three (3) projects must be attributed to the General Contractor of the Design-Build Team.
 - (3) Provide the owner's contact name, agency, address, phone number, and email address.

Offerors shall submit a project narrative with each Form H, "Reference Project Data Sheet". Offerors to identify the narrative with the project number and project name. The narrative is limited to four (4) pages per project.

Project narrative requires the following information in the order listed:

- (1) **Description of Project:** Describe objective of the project, type of project, size and capacity, and major challenges during design and construction.
- (2) Relevancy to this Project: Describe how the project is applicable and relevant to this Project in terms of project scope and size, project delivery method, technical requirements, regulatory and environmental requirements, and operations and maintenance requirements.
- (3) **Scope of Services:** Describe scope of services and/or design work relative to all phases of project delivery.
- (4) **Responsible Firms Role**: Describe specific roles of responsible firms in the design and/or construction of the project. Describe team structure and management.

- (5) **Contract Amount and Change Orders**: Explain whether project was completed within the original contract amount, and Identify/describe the cause of the change such as owner-added scope, unforeseen conditions, design related issues, or other circumstances.
- (6) Contract Schedule: Provide status of reference project completion and any schedule challenges. Explain reason for actual or projected completion date that differs from original scheduled completion date including approved time extensions.
- (7) Claims and Liquidated Damages: For the reference project, describe history of claims, disputes and litigation over \$50,000.00 and how they were resolved. State whether any liquidated damages were assessed and not assessed.
- (8) **Design-Build Team Key Personnel**: Indicate the involvement and responsibilities of the Key Personnel of the Design-Build Entity, highlighting project experience where the Key Personnel of the Design-Build Entity have previously worked together. Refer to Form K: Personnel Experience for a list of the Key Personnel proposed to be assigned to this Project.
- (9) Self-Performance and Participation by Design-Build Team Members: If applicable, identify how the Design-Build Entity held a prime role as the General Contractor, the Principal Engineering Firm, or both, and the extent of self-performance by the General Contractor and include a description of the work that was self-performed. Describe the work that was subcontracted. In addition, describe participation by members of the Design-Build Teams' Key Personnel and respective role(s).
- (10) **Permitting and Compliance**: Describe history of compliance with permit conditions.
- (11) **Design and Construction Management Techniques**: Explain design collaboration approach and project delivery strategy; provide overview of design and construction challenges and how those challenges were addressed; describe any innovative solutions employed.

Offerors to complete and submit the following for the proposed **Other Design Firm Experience**:

- a) Form H Reference Project Data Sheet: Offerors shall submit this form for each of the reference projects, and for other design firms in accordance with the following:
 - (1) For each of the Other Design Firms identified, the Design-Build Entity shall identify a minimum of one (1) and no more than two (2) completed projects by each of the Design Firms. Only reference projects from a maximum two (2) Design Firms will be considered for evaluation and scoring purposes. If there are more than two (2) Design Firms, the Design-Build Entity must identify which two (2) Design Firms it wants to have their reference projects evaluated by the Evaluation Committee.
 - (2) These reference projects shall demonstrate design experience applicable to the requirements for this Project. Design and/or construction experience with operational public works (preferably transportation/transit) facilities and structures.
 - (3) Submit a project narrative following each project form. Identify the narrative with the project number and project name. The narrative is limited to four (4) pages per project. Project narrative must contain the information as required above from the General Contractor and Principal Engineering Firm with the exception of contract amounts and change orders, contract schedule, claims and liquidated damages.

The Design-Build Entity's proposed Project Manager, Principal Engineer, Lead Design Engineer, On-Site Project Manager, and Start-Up Manager for the Project must each have at least ten (10) years relevant professional experience and worked on a minimum of two (2) projects that are comparable to this Project, and in the same role as proposed for this Project.

Key Personnel on the Project are:

- (1) Project Manager, with overall responsibilities for design and/or construction.
- (2) Principal Engineer, Engineer of Record, with primary responsibilities for Design Services under the Design-Build contract.

- (3) Lead Design Engineer or Manager, if different from Item 2 above.
- (4) Lead Electrical Engineer.
- (5) Lead Process Engineer.
- (6) Lead Mechanical Engineer.
- (7) On-Site Project Manager responsible for Project construction.
- (8) Project Superintendent responsible for overseeing day-to-day operations on the construction site.
- (9) Start-Up Manager responsible for planning, coordinating and managing the start-up, testing, and commissioning for all elements and facilities constructed as part of the Project.

Offer to complete and submit the following:

a) Form I - Key Personnel Experience: Offer shall submit Form I for its proposed project team describing all the Key Personnel or equivalent positions listed above. For each person on Form I, Offeror to indicate the role or responsibility this person will have on the Project and provide resumes for each person listed on Form I.

If any of the Key Personnel listed on Form I did not participate in a reference project, then additional project experience is required to be submitted. For the Project Manager, Principal Engineer, Lead Design Engineer, On-Site Project Manager, and Start-Up Manager positions, submit three (3) projects using Form H. For all other proposed Key Personnel, Offerors shall submit one (1) project using Form H.

7. Organizational, Management, Quality and Safety Approach

Offeror to provide organizational charts and narratives that clarify the reporting relationships of individual Key Personnel within that structure. Offeror to provide its approach to managing a quality program for the Project. Offeror to provide its worker safety program approach.

Offeror to provide the following information:

- (1) Description of the Offeror's approach to quality control and validation of administrative functions.
- (2) Description of the Offeror's approach to quality control and validation during design.
- (3) Description of the Offeror's quality control and validation during construction.
- (4) Identification of the method of providing coordination between Authority and the Design-Builder organization.

d) Safety Program

Offeror shall provide the Offeror's safety record for the most recent three-year period, providing an average experience modification rate, an average total recordable injury/illness rate; and average lost work rate as part of Form E, "Design-Build Entity Minimum Requirements".

Offeror shall provide information on Offeror's workers' compensation experience history for the last three years and submit a summary of the Offerors worker safety program, which shall include a description of how the Offeror will provide protection to prevent damage, injury, or loss to employees of the Offeror and its Subcontractors and other persons who are on the project site and minimize lost or restricted workdays due to injuries.

8. Legal Structure

Offeror shall provide organizational documentation as to whether the Design-Build Entity is a privately held corporation, Limited Liability Company, Partnership, Joint Venture, or other legal entity. Provide a copy of the organizational documents or agreement committing to form the Design-Build Entity.

9. Financial Capability

To be submitted per instructions in Section I, Paragraph G. The information provided will be used to determine whether the Design-Build Entity is financially capable of delivering the Project. Offeror shall submit the following:

- (1) Financial statements for the three most recent fiscal years, audited by a certified public accountant in accordance with GAAP or IFRS, for each of the following entities: (1) the Offeror (if available); (2) each joint venture member or general partner of the Offeror (if applicable); and (3) any other entity that will be financially responsible for the Contract. Each financial statements shall include:
 - a) Opinion letter (auditor's report);
 - b) Balance sheet;

 - d) Statement of changes in cash flow; and
 - e) Footnotes.

If financial statements are prepared in accordance with principles other than GAAP or IFRS, the submittal must include a letter from the certified public accountant of the applicable entity, addressing the areas of the financial statements that would be affected by a conversion to GAAP or IFRS, and the financial impact thereof.

If the Offeror is a newly formed entity and does not have independent financial statements, financial statements for the Design-Build team shall be sufficient (and the Offeror shall expressly state that the Offeror is a newly formed entity and does not have independent financial statements). If audited financial statements are not available for an entity, the SOQ shall include unaudited financial statements for such entity, certified as true, correct and complete by the chief financial officer or treasurer of that entity.

The Offerors are advised that, if the SOQ includes unaudited financial statements for any Design-Build Team member, a parent company of such Design-Build Team member will be required to provide a guaranty of the Design-Builder's obligations under Contract. The SOQ shall identify each proposed guarantor and shall include audited financial statements for each proposed guarantor. The Offerors shall also note that even if a Design-Build Team member provides audited financial statements and meets the minimum financial requirements stated in this RFQ, the Authority reserves the right, in its discretion and based upon the review of the information provided in response to this section, to require that the Offeror identify a parent company of such Design-Build Team member to act as a guarantor and provide acceptable financial statements for the proposed guarantor.

If a Offeror or any Offeror team member who submits a financial statement, as required herein, files a report with the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC), then electronic links to the latest SEC Form 10 K and SEC Form 10-Q shall be provided.

- (2) A letter or other written documentation signed by an authorized representative of a surety or insurance company stating that the Offeror is capable of obtaining a Performance Bond and Payment Bond (refer to Section 1.15.1 for bond amounts) covering the Project, notarized and accompanied by appropriate evidence of authorization. Letters indicating "unlimited" bonding capability are not acceptable;
- (3) Insurance certifications, either a certificate of insurance evidencing current policies of, or written evidence from an insurance company or broker indicating that the Offeror is capable of complying with Exhibit B, Insurance Requirements.

SECTION III. EVALUATION AND AWARD

A. EVALUATION CRITERIA

The SOQs will be reviewed, evaluated and ranked by the evaluation committee according to the requirements and criteria outlined in this section.

All SOQs will first be reviewed for their responsiveness, and inclusion of all required forms. Any SOQ that is incomplete in any material respect may be deemed nonresponsive and may be rejected in its entirety. SOQs will first be reviewed using the pass-fail criteria below, and advance into evaluation if they pass.

1. Minimum Requirements

Pass-Fail Criteria

The initial evaluation of Design-Build Entities will be based on information provided on Form E, "Design-Build Minimum Requirements". If the Design-Build Entity "fails" any questions 1 through 20, listed on Form E, they will be disqualified from further evaluation (except with respect to Question 20 to the extent the Design-Build Entity is a party to an alternative dispute resolution system as identified in Question 20).

2. Legal Structure

Form F, "General Contractor Questions", Form G, "Principal Engineer Questions" and the organizational documents or agreement committing to form the Design-Build Entity.

3. Financial Capability

Pass-Fail Criteria

The information provided in Section II, "Statement of Qualification Content", Paragraph A.9., will be used to evaluate the Design-Build Entity's ability to deliver the Project using criteria as reasonably determined by the Authority which may include:

- (1) Profitability and potential for growth.
- (2) Solvency.
- (3) Financial challenges in the past and anticipated in the near future and how the entity has and is addressing those challenges.
- (4) Bond, credit, and other ratings.

4. Design-Build Entity and Team Experience

30%

The information provided specified in Section II, "Statement of Qualification Content", Paragraph A.5., will be used to evaluate the Design-Build Entity's and Design-Build Team's experience based on the following criteria:

- (1) Experience of the Design-Build Entity and firms comprising the Design-Build Entity and Design-Build Team with alternative project delivery methods (i.e., Design-Build, Progressive Design-Build, Design-Build-Operate, Construction Manager at Risk, etc.). Specific experience with Design-Build project delivery method is highly desirable.
- (2) Prior working relationships of the firms comprising the Design-Build Entity and Design-Build Team.
- (3) Experience with planning and design of projects similar in size, scope and cost to this Project.
- (4) Experience with construction and construction management of projects similar in size, type and cost to this Project.
- (5) Experience with startup and commissioning of public works (preferably transit) projects.
- (6) Experience with providing post-construction services such as initial operations support and process optimization services for transit facilities.
- (7) Demonstrated experience in outreach efforts with the public; agencies having jurisdiction; other interested public, private agencies and parties during design as well as construction of similar projects.

5. Key Personnel Experience

30%

The information provided in Section II, "Statement of Qualification Content", Paragraph A.6. will be used to evaluate the Design-Build Entity's Key Personnel experience using the following criteria:

(1) Key Personnel's design and design management experience and past performance on projects of size, scope and cost comparable to this Project.

- (2) Key Personnel's construction and construction management experience and past performance on projects of size, type and cost comparable to this Project.
- (3) Key Personnel have had prior working relationships on referenced projects.
- (4) Key Personnel's experience with alternative project delivery methods (Design-Build, Construction Manager at Risk, Design-Build Operate, etc.). Specific experience with design-build project delivery method is highly desirable.
- (5) Successful implementation of quality control management plans during project design.
- (6) Successful implementation of construction quality control management plans during project construction.
- (7) Key Personnel's experience in planning, managing and performing project startup, commissioning and owner staff training.
- (8) Key Personnel's experience in providing post-construction services such as initial operations support and process optimization support.

B. EVALUATION PROCEDURE

The Authority will ascertain whether the SOQ has satisfied the pass-fail criteria as described in Section III, "Evaluation and Award", Paragraph A.1-3.

An evaluation committee will be appointed to review all SOQs received for this RFQ. The committee is comprised of Authority staff and may include outside personnel. The committee members will evaluate the written SOQs using criteria and weights identified in Section III, "Evaluation and Award", Paragraph A. 4-6. Based upon the information provided in the SOQs, a list of qualified Design-Build

Teams will be developed ("short-list"). The Authority will notify all Offerors who submit an SOQ in response to this RFQ of the short-listed teams.

The anticipated Transit Committee date for the presentation of the short-list and approval to release the RFP for this Project is anticipated to be January 9, 2025. Offerors will be notified of the short-list seven (7) calendar days prior to that date.

PROJECT BACKGROUND

General Summary of Work:

The Orange County Transportation Authority (AUTHORITY) owns, operates, and maintains the Garden Grove Bus Base located at 11790 Cardinal Circle, Garden Grove. CA 92843. The AUTHORITY is seeking a qualified contractor (DESIGN-BUILDER) to design, construct, and deliver a turnkey code-compliant Hydrogen Fueling Station and Facility Modifications at its Garden Grove Bus Base. DESIGN-BUILDER shall complete the design of the project, and obtain all required approvals from authorities having jurisdiction prior to proceeding with construction. DESIGN-BUILDER shall deliver the project fully commissioned and ready for use, and meet all performance requirements through demonstrated performance testing. The AUTHORITY requires hydrogen fueling for up to 100 fuel cell electric buses (FCEBs) using two fuel lanes with total daily fuel consumption of up to 3,000 kilograms. Facility modifications are needed at existing maintenance facilities affected by the introduction of hydrogen system to the property including the fuel building, maintenance building, brake check building, canopy detail area, vehicle test station canopy, tire shop area, a maintenance platform with a canopy structure to service AUTHORITY's bus fleet. There is no scope split, the AUTHORITY shall not perform any work on the project.

Environmental Review:

The Project has been environmentally cleared by the Authority. Pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act, the project was determined to be Categorically Exempt, and a Notice of Exemption was filed in February 2024 with the Orange County Recorder's Office and the Governor's Office of Planning and Research State Clearinghouse.

PROCUREMENT BACKGROUND

Short-listing and Procurement Process:

Authority intends to use a two-step process to select a Design-Build Contractor to deliver the Project. The process will include the following two steps:

- a) Request for Qualifications (RFQ): This RFQ is issued as part of the first step to solicit information, in the form of SOQs, that Authority will evaluate to determine which Offerors are the most highly qualified to successfully deliver the Project. The Authority will use the SOQ process to develop a short list of Offerors.
- b) Request for Proposals (RFP): Authority will then issue an RFP to the short-listed Offerors, requesting submittals of proposals that Authority will evaluate to determine which proposal offers the best value. Authority, in its sole discretion, will award a design-build contract for the Project to the Offeror offering the best value proposal. Specific details concerning the RFP step of the procurement and any modifications to the above will be set forth in the RFP.

CONTRACTOR shall procure and continuously maintain in full force and effect through contract completion, insurance coverages specified herein. Coverages shall not be subject to self-insurance provisions. CONTRACTOR shall provide the following insurance coverage:

- 2. Automobile Liability to include owned, hired and non-owned autos with a combined single limit of \$1,000,000 each accident;
- 3. Workers' Compensation with limits as required by the State of California, including waiver of subrogation, in favor of AUTHORITY, its officers, directors, employees and agents.
- 4. Builders All Risk policy or course of construction including earthquake and flood coverage with minimum limits of \$(project amount).
 - 5. Employers' Liability with minimum limits of \$1,000,000
- 6. Professional Liability with minimum limits of \$2,000,000 per occurrence and \$4,000,000 general aggregate;
- 7. Pollution Liability with minimum limits of \$2,000,000 per occurrence and \$4,000,000 general aggregate.

Prior to commencement of any work hereof, CONTRACTOR shall furnish to AUTHORITY's Contract Administrator broker-issued insurance certificate showing the required insurance coverages and further providing that:

AUTHORITY, its officers, directors, employees and agents must be named as additional insured on Commercial General Liability and Automobile Liability policy with respect to performance hereunder; and

The coverage shall be primary and noncontributory as to any other insurance with respect to performance hereunder; and

Thirty (30) days prior written notice of cancellation or material change be given to

AUTHORITY.

In addition, CONTRACTOR shall provide insurance policy blanket endorsement.

"Occurrence," as used herein, means any event or related exposure to conditions, which result in bodily injury or property damage.

The Certificate of Insurance shall reference Agreement Number C-X-XXXX and, the Contract Administrator's Name, Megan Bornman.

Upon AUTHORITY's request, certified, true and exact copies of each of the insurance policies shall be provided to AUTHORITY.

AUTHORITY shall notify CONTRACTOR in writing of any changes in the requirements to insurance required to be provided by CONTRACTOR. Except as set forth in this Article, any additional cost from such change shall be paid by AUTHORITY and any reduction in cost shall reduce the contract price pursuant to a change order.

CONTRACTOR shall also include in each subcontract the stipulation that subcontractors shall maintain coverage in the amounts required as provided in this Agreement.

CONTRACTOR shall be required to immediately notify AUTHORITY of any modifications or cancellation of any required insurance policies.
