Health, Safety & Environment Requirements

 Prior to contractor's mobilization onto the Project, the contractor must have a full time qualified Health, Safety and Environmental (HSE) Representative. The required qualifications of the (HSE) Representative are as follows:

1. Certified Safety Professional (CSP) with current standing from the Board of Certified Safety Professionals (BCSP); OR

2. Construction Health and Safety Technician (CHST) with current standing with BCSP; OR

3. Certified Industrial Hygienist (CIH) with current standing from the American Board of Certified Industrial Hygienist (CIH) with current standing from the American Board of Industrial Hygiene (ABIH); OR

4. Equal professional HSE Certificate of standing from the National Examination Board in Occupational Safety and Health (NEBOSH), that is acceptable to the Authority.

- The Contractor's HSE Representative will be a **full time on-site person** and shall provide a resume demonstrating **7 years' experience** in administering HSE programs in heavy construction projects
- The Contractor's HSE Representative will prepare a detailed Site Specific HSE Plan, that includes identification of known & potential hazards of Contractor's scope and the mitigation methods that will be utilized (execution plan, job hazard analysis, etc.). The HSE plan should mirror the same line items of the schedule and identify the hazards, tools & equipment, and safe work methods for each task listed on the schedule.

The following items are for OCTA to review. These documents should remain in the possession of OCTA through duration of the contractor scope of work.

The contractor shall submit electronic copies of the items listed below for contract scope work on OCTA projects and property. Copies shall be provided **prior** to contractor's mobilization onto OCTA projects and property.

Required Safety Submittals:

- Copy of Contractor's Safety Manual
- Copy of Contractor 's Injury Illness Prevention Program (IIPP)
- Copy of Contractor Substance Abuse Prevention Program
- Copy of Contractor's Hazard Communication Program & SDS management
- Name, Qualifications & Resume of Contractor Site HSE Representative (CHST or CSP certification from the Board of Certified Safety Professionals (BCSP) and 5 Years of HSE compliance experience & Knowledge of rail safety)
- Copy of NFPA 70-E training certificate, electrical activities (all electrical personnel involved)
- A list of Contractor's Personnel anticipated to be on site (including sub-tier contractors)
- A method to identify Contractor's personnel (badge, logo on clothing or hat, uniform, etc.)

Health, Safety & Environment Requirements

- Prior to commencing scope work the Contractor shall conduct and submit to OCTA Project Manager, a copy of Contractor's HSE Orientation for workers, sub-contractors, vendors and visitors; The safety orientation at a minimum shall include, as applicable,
 - Personal Protection Equipment (PPE) requirements
 - ANSI class 2 reflective vests
 - Designated smoking, eating, sanitation facilities, and parking areas
 - Traffic routing, 10 MPH speed limit, postings, and barricade requirements
 - Maintain a safe pedestrian path of travel plan
 - Emergency procedures and evacuation assembly areas
 - No cell phone use, or similar devices in vehicle traffic areas of the work areas and within 25 feet of rail track work zone
 - Documented weekly safety meetings
 - When required by scope work; additional orientation information shall include fall protection, energy isolation/lock-out/tag-out (LOTO) NFPA 70-E training, confined space, hot work permit, security requirements, and similar project safety requirements
 - A documented HSE orientation that includes topics covered, date, employee printed name and signature shall be submitted to the Authority Project Manager upon initial mobilization, and as necessary through completion of the project
